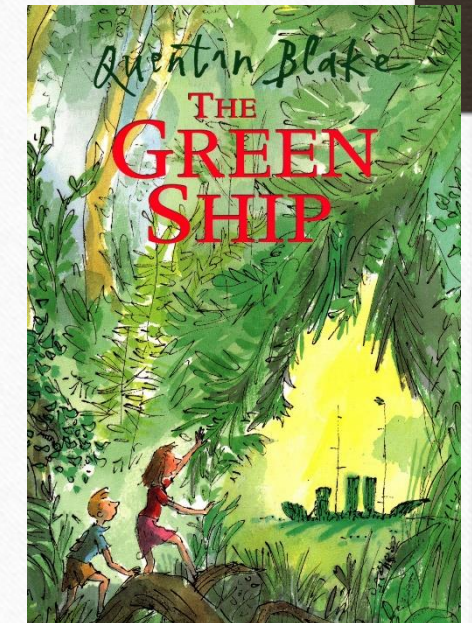
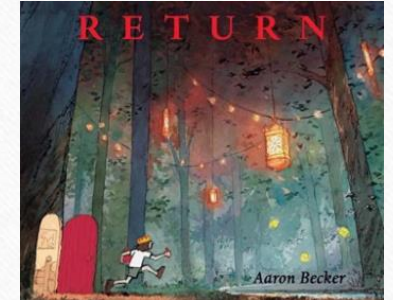

What will we do in Term 1?
