Roles and responsibilities of Digital Leaders and feedback from children regarding online safety

During our first meeting of the year we discussed our role as helping all children to be SAFE. We talked about what our badges represent and shared safety online tips and concerns.

We are representatives from Y2-6 and our role is to keep up to date and share ideas so we can keep all children safe online. We know to never share personal information online.

Concerns were based around children playing games that were too old for them and uploading videos to social media. Our role to promote safety and share ideas about safety online discussed by the Leaders. We knew online concerns could be from any device including phones and smart TVs.

Within our group we have played or know children who have played or used: Minecraft, Roblox, YouTube, Netflix, Fifa, Musically*, Call of Duty*, Saints Row*, The floor is Lava, Pineapple Pen, Clash of the Clans, GTA* and Guymart*. We discussed which of these have a PEGI rating or age limit that would mean they were a concern* if children were using them. We also talked about things that could go wrong using any game, social media or online facility. We were very pleased that all within the group knew to tell an adult to get help and knew how to report a problem either via the game / program itself or via the REPORT ABUSE button on our Pupil Zone webpage
