Parent Portal also gives some really useful information about the importance of speech and language development. The Development Tab goes in to more detail about the steps that each child goes through during the stages of their development.


Each week, we will share an activity with you that you may wish to do with your child at home.

1 STRICTLY ROBOTS	Strictly Robots - A video activity for helping your child follow a set of instructions in the right order.
2 GUESS WHAT?	Guess What - A second video activity showing you how to help your child describe a set of objects.
3 	Mini Olympics - This activity will help your child practise saying and listening to sequencing words such as first, last, before and after. It's also

<p>6</p> 	<p>Yes/No game - An activity to help your child name things in a group and make links between them.</p>
