English

This term we will be consolidating our learning so far:

- Using nouns, verbs and adjectives
- Forming letters correctly and writing on the line.
 - Writing with spaces between words.
 - Using correct punctuation . ! ?
- Use capital letters for the start of a sentence and for proper nouns.
 - Writing in the past tense

Maths

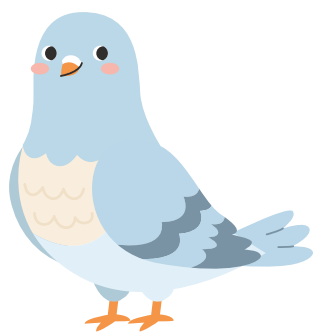
In Maths, we will be continuing our focus on place value within numbers to 50 exploring numbers to 50, the children will be continuing to learn to count in groups of 2s, 5s and 10s as well as identifying how many tens and ones make up a number. We will also start exploring fractions.

Science

In Science, we will be continuing our focus on plants. The children will be exploring the parts of a tree and parts of a flowering plant. We will compare plants and look at the different seasons. In addition to this, we will be learning about wild and garden plants and going on a plant hunt to see what we can find around the school.

Geography

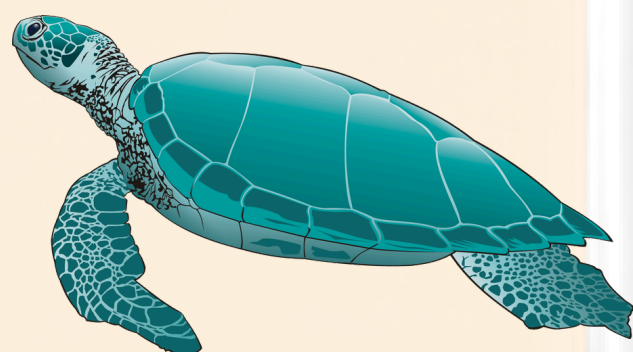
In Geography this term, we will learning the names of the 5 oceans, looking at the sea life within them and how we can help to make our ocean a better place to live. As you know we have our visit to Hastings Aquarium, the RLNI and the beach on Tuesday 16th June.



Art

In Art we will be creating a wire bird sculpture.

In PSHE, we will be thinking about ways we can be kind and will be working towards answering the question 'how can we look after each other and the world?' The children will be learning about respect, caring for animals and the environment. We will be finishing the term, considering ways in which we can manage the change moving up into year two.

Revisit unit 20 /air/ air, are, ear, ere, eir, ayer, ayor
