English

We will be consolidating all learning from the past year throughout this term.

We will use Roald Dahl's *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory* as a fun intro to this term's writing.



Maths

We are continuing our learning of fractions.

$$\frac{1}{2} \quad \frac{1}{4} \quad \frac{1}{3}$$

We will also be exploring time and money.

If you are able to have discussion at home around an analogue clock and the use of money, this would help support your child's learning.



Science

This term we will be learning about living things and food chains.

We will explore how living things depend on each other for food and survival.

Nearer the end of term we hope to create a range of habitats for mini beasts in our woodland area.



Geography

This term we will be exploring countries that make up the UK.
