LONDON'S BURNING

Yesterday, 2nd September, a devastating fire broke out at Pudding Lane in a bakery owned by Thomas Farriner. Hundreds of homes have been destroyed and many people now are homeless as a result.

The fire began in the bakery around 1 am, after Thomas Farriner forgot to put the oven fire out. A spark from the oven, ignited nearby wood, which then spread quickly across London. Before the fire started there had been a 10-month long drought in London, making the city very dry. A terrified witness said "the fire spread really quickly and I had to escape my home across the roof. I now have nowhere to live. I feel really sad and scared about what's going to happen next".
