- 5 I am currently writing a children's book.

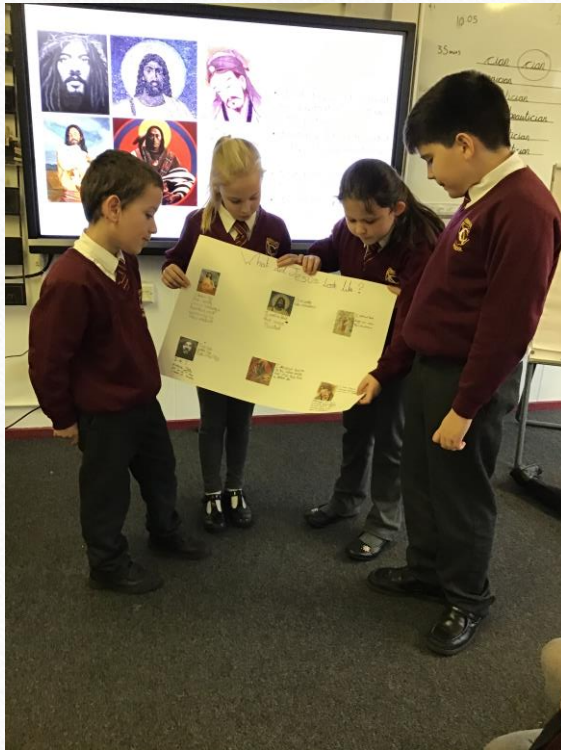
Purple Mash Live Blog Chat

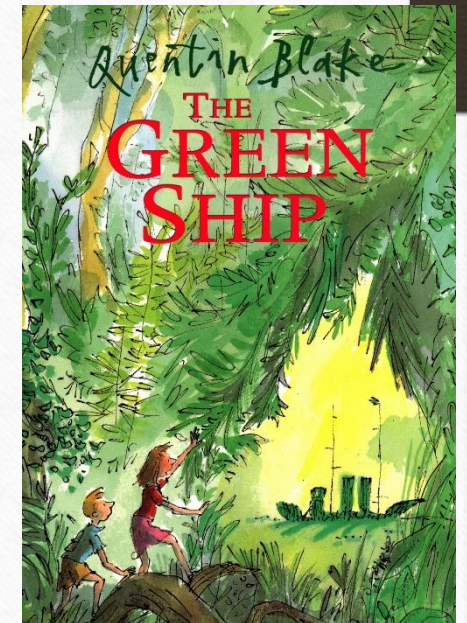
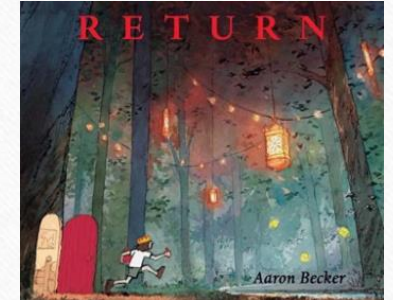
