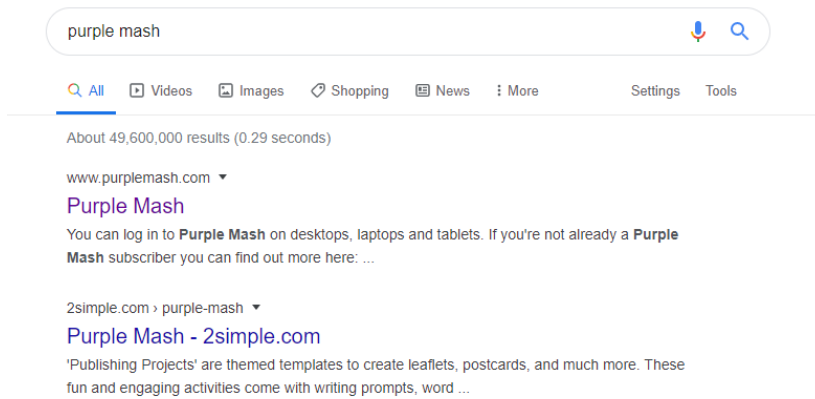


# How to use your class blog on Purple Mash

## 1. Type Purple Mash into Google and click the first result.



## 2. You will see a screen like the one below. Please click on Find my school's login page.

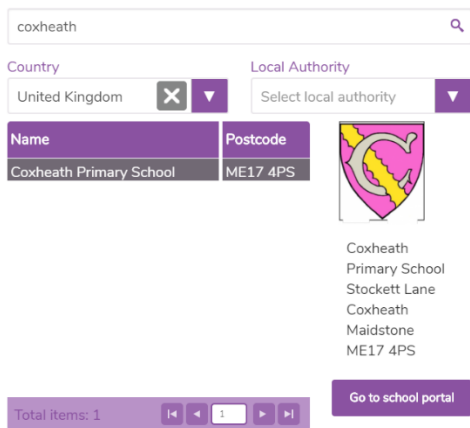

## 3. Search for Coxheath Primary School.

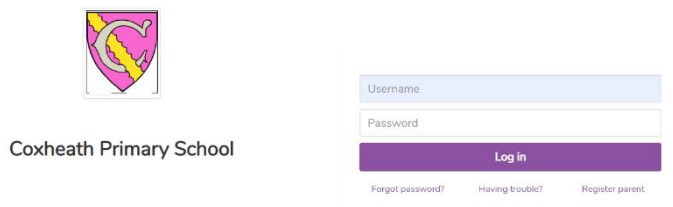

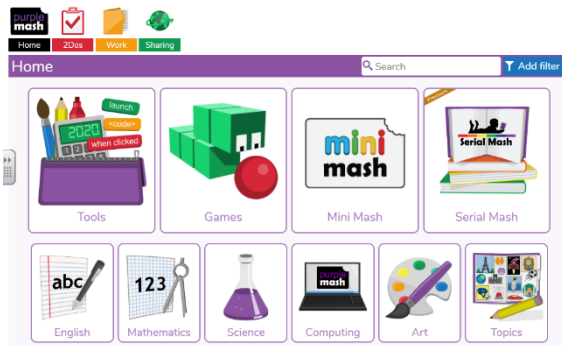
**4. When you see a page like the one below, click on Go to School Portal.**



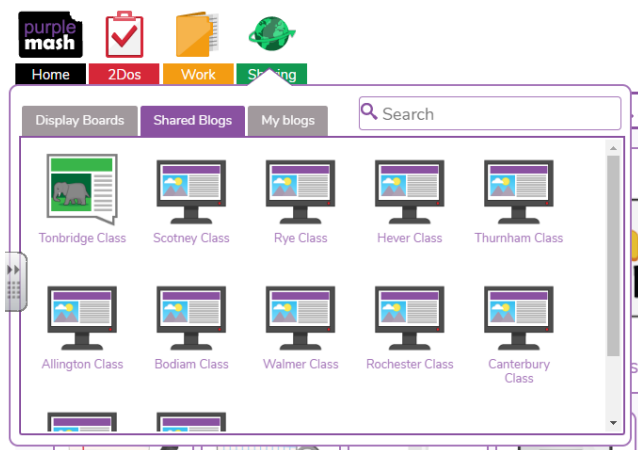
**5. Enter your username and password.**



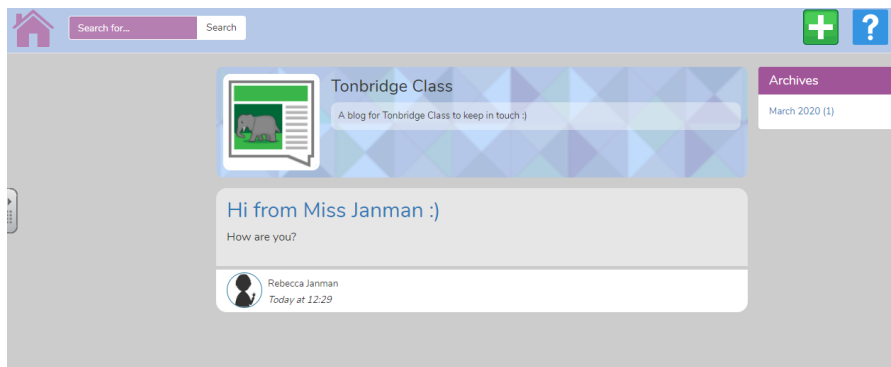
**6. You will see a screen like the one below. To access your class blog, click on the sharing tab in the top left hand corner.**
