

Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you to those of you that have accessed the work we have provided on Mini Mash this week. We hope the past few days have gone well and that the children have been enjoying the tasks set. We have been looking through Mini Mash and we are really pleased with what the children have been doing, so thank you for your continued support.

As well as providing work on Mini Mash we would like to provide additional resources for your child to access at home. To be able to do this, we will be using Google classroom and Bug Club. The children will be receiving a username and password for both of these. Google classroom will be used for daily Phonics sessions, PE activities and readings of story books. Bug Club is an online platform that allows children to work through reading books tailored to their level. It also contains quizzes that the children can complete. They each have an account and once they have worked through a set of books their teacher can move their reading forward.

To ensure each of the children are being challenged in Phonics we have split them into four groups. These are the same groups that we have in school. There will be four different videos uploaded to Google classroom for Phonics. Please make sure your child is watching the correct video for their group. The table below shows which group your child is in and which video they should work through.

Group 1 videos	Group 2 videos	Group 3 videos	Group 4 videos
