Headteacher News

The children were so excited about performing for you and their enthusiasm and enjoyment was matched only by the quality of performance they gave. Well done to all the Year R children who certainly filled our hearts with joy and Christmas spirit. A huge thank you to the dedicated Year R team who worked so hard to enable the children to perform so successfully and who provide such wonderful experiences during their first year at school.

Another huge thank you to Kingswood Christmas trees who once again have been incredibly generous and provided the school with two beautiful Christmas trees. I am sure most of you will already have your tree up, but if you haven't, vouchers are available at reception for £5 off if you still need to purchase a tree.

Thank you to all of our parents for completing the parent surveys. These have now closed and we will share the outcome of these results in the New Year. The children are also in the process of completing their surveys and the results of both will hopefully be available to share during our first parent council meeting on the 11th January.

We are noticing that for some of our children, their uniform is not in line with the school expectations and we would ask that children return in the New Year adhering to our school uniform policy.

All children should be dressed according to the following:

- · White blouse / shirt
- · School jumper or cardigan with logo
- · School tie (Optional for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 Classes)
- Grey skirt / trousers / shorts
- · Grey socks (Children may also wear grey tights or white socks)
- · Suitable plain black shoes
- Children may wear grey pinafore dresses and red summer dresses during appropriate times of the year (without ties)

We consider our school uniform to be a crucial part of the high expectations that we have for our school. Your support is very much appreciated, and we would ask that all parents ensure that children come to school dressed appropriately, without nail varnish and with only plain stud earrings and watches for jewellery. We also ask that children do not wear large bows in their hair. This is particularly important for our year six pupils who are preparing for their transition to secondary. From personal experience with my own children, there is no leniency when it comes to uniform expectations in secondary schools and sanctions are in place for those children who do not adhere to them.
